Mobile Money® Use your smart phone for VB on the go!

Mobile Money® is a service that allows you to log into Virtual Branch (VB) from your cell phone by use of the down-loadable application "Touch Banking". To get started, log into VB from your computer, select the SELF SERVICE tab and follow the steps to register your phone. You can even sign up to use texting to get your balance, history and do transfers. For more information visit www.co-opcreditunion.com and select Mobile Money under the ELECTRONIC SERVICES tab. According to the IRS, no legitimate IRS employee would ever:

- Call to demand immediate payment
- Demand that you pay taxes without giving you the chance to ask about or appeal the amount in question
- Require you to use a specific payment method for your taxes, such as a prepaid debit card
- Ask for credit or debit card numbers over the phone
- Threaten to bring in law-enforcement to have you arrested for not paying



If a scammer calls you, hang up immediately, and report the call to the Federal Trade Commission using the complaint assistant at FTC.gov.
